Subject: Upgradation of ITIs in the State of Rajasthan under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of "Upgradation of ITIs into Centres of Excellence"- Equipment procurement for Broad Based /Advanced Training in existing ITIs: regarding

Sir,

This has reference to the letter of even No. dated 20.12.2005 and 25.7.2006 wherein sanction of the President was accorded for an amount of Rs.262.24 and Rs.26.23 lakh were released as 10% towards the 1st installment of Central share for procurement of Equipment for the ITI of Jaipur, Jodhpur, Kota, Alwar and Udaipur under the scheme "Upgradation of ITIs into Centres of Excellence" for BBT and advanced training during the Financial Year 2005-2006 & 2006-2007.

2. This also refers this Directorate Generals Letter of even no. dated 26/2/07 in which Rs.33.74 lakhs (Rupees thirty three lakh and Seventy four thousand only) equivalent to 40% of the central funds towards 2nd installment were released to the State Government of Rajasthan for the purchase of equipment for the above ITIs.

3. Now I am directed to release a further amount of Rs. 22.06 lakh (Rupees twenty two lakh and Six thousands only) equivalent to 70% of the central funds towards 2nd installment (IInd lot) to the State Government of Rajasthan for the purchase of equipment for the above ITI as per the details given below:

4. The release of Central fund of Rs. 22.06 lakhs in respect of the said scheme is subject to the following conditions:

- (i) The equipment purchased should be strictly in accordance with the standard list of tools and equipment, as prescribed by NCVT for the particular trade.

- (ii) The grant shall be utilized keeping in view the guidelines of the Scheme/MoU and only for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned and no portion of it shall be spent on any other item.
 - (iii) The amount sanctioned should be utilized within a period of one year from the date of issue of the sanction and any amount not spent by that time should be surrendered to the Central Government.
 - (iv) The Utilisation Certificate in Form GFR 19-A indicating component-wise expenditure under the scheme should be furnished to the Directorate General in Duplicate.
 - (v) After making purchases, bid documents, bids, bid evaluation reports and letter of award should be retained by the State Directorate for post-award review by DGE&T.
 - (vi) IMC clearance should be obtained before procurement of equipment.
5. The sanction relates to Plan Expenditure and is in accordance with the pattern of assistance approved by the Planning Commission and Ministry of Finance.
6. **The expenditure is debitable to the following Head of Account:-**

Major Head "3601" – Grants-in-Aid to State Governments:
