TENDER NOTICE

Subject:- Sale of old and condemned Cars - regarding.

Ministry of Labour and Employment is proposing to dispose of three Staff Cars on "as is where is basis". Details of the vehicles are as under:-

2. Accordingly, sealed quotations are invited for the sale of the said above vehicles on the terms and conditions mentioned below. Interested Person/firms to purchase the above mentioned staff cars/vehicles, may submit their quotations in the enclosed proforma in a sealed cover addressed to the undersigned latest by 3.00 P.M. on **15th May, 2017**. The quotations received in time will be opened at 04:00 P.M. on or before 15th May, 2017. The cover should be prominently mentioned with the words "QUOTATION FOR PURCHASE OF CONDEMNED VEHICLE". The vehicles will be available for inspection between 03:00 PM. to 04:00 PM on 04 & 05 May, 2017.

3. The quotation received in time will be opened by the bid evaluation Committee in Room No. 518, Shram Shakti Bhawan, Rafi Marg, New Delhi. The bidders or their representatives (not more than one for each quotation) may present, if they so desire, at the time of opening of Quotations.

4. The sale will be governed by the following conditions:-

- a) The bidders are required to pay Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five thousand Only) for each vehicle payable by means of Demand Draft/FDR from any of the commercial bank, drawn in favour of PAO(MS) Ministry of Labour and Employment, New Delhi (payment by cheque or cash shall not be accepted).
- b) Quotations received without Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will not be considered and will be rejected.

- c) The successful bidder will be required to deposit the bid amount by means of Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque from any commercial bank drawn in favour of PAO(MS) Ministry of Labour and Employment, New Delhi within seven working days of the acceptance of the bid.
- d) The EMD of the successful bidder will be released only after the deposit of the sale proceeds. Earnest Money will not be adjusted as sale proceeds and will be forfeited, if he fails to honour the bid.
- e) The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status viz. Aadhar Card/Voter Identity Card/Ration Card/Passport in case of individual and Registration Certificate, in case of firms etc.
- f) The sold vehicle has to be removed by the successful bidder within five days of depositing the bidding amount at his own expenses.
- g) The vehicle will be disposed of on "as is where is basis" and no guarantee for its worthiness or quality will be given by this Ministry.
- h) The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the Vehicle transferred in his name at his own cost expeditiously. This Ministry will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
- i) The bidders will not be allowed to withdraw their bids and if they do so their earnest Money Deposit (EMD) will be forfeited.
- j) The Competent Authority in Ministry of Labour & Employment reserves the right to accept or reject any /all of the quotations without assigning any reason.
- k) Proforma for offering rate for disposal of Condemned vehicle is available at Annexure-I.
- l) Bids will be assessed in respect of each vehicle separately. Highest bidder in respect of each particular vehicle will be the successful bidder.
- m) Bidders who have quoted rates for all the three vehicles, but on assessing, if he becomes successful bidder only for one/two vehicles, he will have to honour the bid even for one/two vehicles. If he fails to honour the bid, his EMD will be forfeited.
